President Wheaton asked for public input. President Wheaton informed the Board of two customers who had contacted him regarding the 24-hour water order rule when they received a water order memo from the District. Mr. Wheaton verified the amount of the penalty at \$20.00 for not calling in a water order and \$100.00 during frost weather.

MONTHLY REPORTS

Treasurer Nelms reviewed with the Board the financial status of the District, including TBID Investment Policy Review in Compliance with SB 564 and SB 866. Included in the review; monthly statements from California Bank & Trust and Local Agency Investment Fund, Friant Power Authority revenues and expenditure summary worksheet. Reviewed Delinquent Water accounts report. TBID preliminary balance sheet as of April 30, 2019, as well as Income Statements for the same period, including a year to date statement, was reviewed.

Albert Smith, Operations Superintendent, presented his monthly operating activities report for May 2019. Mr. Smith stated no accidents or injuries to report for the month of May. The District replaced faulty overload unit on the starter for the pond pump at the treatment plant. Jorgensen serviced the fire extinguishers, SCE performed pump testing on all pumps and wells. The floor around the Moss Screen at Bradford Station was replaced. Weeding and clean up at stations #7, #8, and #3; Greased all pumps and motors at stations #7, #8, and #3.

Equipment Maintenance and repair included replaced radiator hose on the 580L backhoe.

At WTP the average flow through the plant is around 650 gpm. Repaired 1 main line leak one on Ave 84 west of M-109 AC line break.

The total precipitation is 14.87 inches. USA locates: 17 Backflow's Tested: 53

Current projects include replacing 1,320 feet of main line on Avenue 76 with 6 inch PVC and repaint all stations.

Friant Power Authority: President Wheaton advised TBID Board of action taken by the FPA Board to fund a new reserve account for future repair or replacement of the 70KV Line.

Status of Authorities; ESPA, DCTRA, FWA, ACWA & AECA: Friant Water Authority is keeping everyone updated by emails.
