Included in the review; monthly statements from California Bank & Trust, Local Agency Investment Fund, Friant Power Authority revenues and expenditure summary worksheet. Delinquent water account report was reviewed.

TBID balance sheet as of October 31, 2019, as well as Income Statements for the same period, including a year to date statement was reviewed.

Albert Smith, Operations Superintendent, presented his monthly operating activities report for November 2019. Mr. Smith had no accidents or injuries to report for the month of November. Equipment maintenance and repair included replacement of the door handle on car #6 and service of the 580 L backhoe. Operations repaired one main line leak on the corner of Road 248 and Avenue 92, installed new station signs and winterized all stations. Weeded and cleaned up stations #7, #8, and #3. Greased all pumps and motors at stations #7, #8, and #3.

WTP average flow through the plant is around 625 gpm. Repaired the chain on the clarifier.
