#### **MONTHLY REPORTS**

Treasurer Nelms reviewed with the Board the financial status of the District, including TBID Investment Policy Review in Compliance with SB 564 and SB 866. Included in the review; monthly statements from California Bank & Trust, Local Agency Investment Fund, Friant Power Authority revenues and expenditure summary worksheet. Delinquent water account report was reviewed noting increase in delinquent water accounts from the prior month.

TBID balance sheet's as of July 31, 2020 as well as Income Statements for the same period, including a year to date statements were reviewed.

Albert Smith, Operations Superintendent, presented his monthly operating activities report for August 2020. Mr. Smith reported there is no employee accidents or matter in August.

Equipment maintenance and repair included greasing all pumps and motors at stations #7, #8, and #9. Replaced tires on Car #6. Replaced capacitor on Treatment Plant A/C unit. Replaced the blower motor belt at Station #9 A/C unit. Treatment plant generator had an electrical short on the charging unit. Operation repairs and maintenance included weeding and clean up at staions #7, #8, and #9. Cleaning moss screens twice a day at Station #9 to remove milfoil and algae.

WTP average flow through the plant is around 750 gpm. Quarterly THM's taken. Replaced 2 meters.

The total precipitation is  $\underline{7.41}$  inches YTD. USA locates: 16. Back flow's Tested: 30

Mr. Smith informed the Board that owner of meter 34-5 is watering land outside the district, he informed the owner to cease and desist, discussed options with the owner, the owner will remove trees and not use Distrit water on that property. Manager Geivet will follow up with a letter to the customer.

Manager Geivet presented his monthly report. He reported that the District will have approximately 2,900 acre feet of carry over water for this water year. Manager Geivet reported the Fraint-Kern Canal is going to be dewatered from November 1, 2020 to January 2021. There will be no frost protection available during this time. Domestic users will be on well water and winter well options discussed. Discussion followed on de-water plans. Manager Geivet will be checking with M&I customers to see what their needs will be during this time.

**Friant Power Authority**: Manager Geivet reported there was no FPA BOD meeting this month, but will call FPA to discuss the backup transformer maintenaince plans.

**Status of Authorities; ESPA, DCTRA, FWA, ACWA & AECA**: Manager Geivet reported FWA is focused on canal repairs, the Engineers are looking at the turn out conversions for the new canal design. TBID's engineers are also looking at the plans and design to determine the best option for TBID's pumping turnout. Discussion followed on the canal turnout and pumping station.

Eastern Tule GSA: Nothing new to report.
