Treasurer Nelms reviewed with the Board the financial status of the District, including TBID Investment Policy Review in Compliance with SB 564 and SB 866. Included in the review; monthly statements from California Bank & Trust and Local Agency Investment Fund. Friant Power Authority revenues and expenditure summary worksheet. Delinquent water account report was reviewed and discussed.

TBID Preliminary balance sheet as of March 30, 2021 as well as Income Statements for the same period, including a year-to-date statement were reviewed and discussed.

Albert Smith, Operations Superintendent, presented his monthly operating activities report for April 2021. Mr. Smith report no employee matters and no accidents or injuries for the month..

Equipment maintenance and repairs report included all pumps and motors greased at station #7, #8, and #4. Serviced plate compactor. Replaced battery on the front loader 580c. Operations maintenance and repair report included weeding and cleaned up at stations #7, #8, and #4. Repaired pump #7 valve at station #9. Received EAR report, and completed EAR report.

WTP average flow through the plant is around 600 GPM.

4 mainline leaks in April; 2 on Road 256 about 100 yards North of Avenue 95, 1 on Avenue 96 about 200 yards West of Road 264, and 1 on the corner of Road 264 and Avenue 76

The total precipitation is <u>4.67</u>inches. USA locates: 27. Back flow's Tested: 36

Manager Geivet presented his monthly report. Mr. Geivet reported the Bureau allocation is still at 20%. Discussion followed on possible changes to the allocation and upcoming Bureau meeting.

Friant Power Authority: Expencing low water flow.

Status of Authorities; ESPA, DCTRA, FWA, ACWA & AECA: FWA - Bureau discussed the upcoming meetings for both the FWA and the Bureau on the FKC allocation. Manager Geivet brought to the Board's attention FWA is limiting the close session meeting to Directors only, after discussion the Board concurred they prefer to have TBID's Manager present along with the TBID Director and to work on resolving this issue.
