# **MONTHLY REPORTS**

Treasurer Nelms reviewed with the Board the financial status of the District, including TBID Investment Policy Review in Compliance with SB 564 and SB 866. Included in the review is the monthly statements from California Bank & Trust, Local Agency Investment Fund, Friant Power Authority revenue and expenditure summary worksheet, along with the delinquent water account report was reviewed.

TBID balance sheet as of September 30, 2021 as well as Income Statements for the same period, including year-to-date statements were reviewed.

Albert Smith, Operations Superintendent, presented his monthly operating activities report for October 2021 Mr. Smith stated no accidents or injuries to report. Alex Martinez is out on medical leave until the end of November.

Equipment maintenance and repair on station 34 600 amp buss cleaned up and buss bolts replaced. Car #3 had two motor mounts replaced. Greased all pumps and motors at stations #7, #8, and #4. Operations maintenance and repair report included weeding and cleaned up at stations #1, #2, and #4. Disc around treatment plant. 4" meter installed for Deer Creek Citrus for wheeling water. Getting electric quotes for the wells at station #3.

WTP average flow through the plant is around 500 gpm. Replaced the air valve actuator in the valve room.

1 main line leaks in October; at Avenue 90 East of Road 248.

The total precipitation is <u>1.62</u> inches YTD. USA locates: 15. Back flow's Tested: 10

Mr. Keller presented the monthly water report. The Water allocation increased to 25% Class 1 at November 1, 2021. The Water Schedule has been adjusted to reflect the current available carry over for the new water year starting March, the Bureau is allowing 10% of contract carryover. October 2021 actual delivery was 1,096 acre feet. Discussion followed on water availability.

**Fraint Water Authority** President Wheaton updated the board on the upcoming FWA Director's Retreat in Paso Robles November 15<sup>th</sup> to 17th. FWA will be replacing COO Doug DeFlitch.

Friant Power Authority: Backup transformers are in, discussion followed on the water flow on the river.

**Status of Authorities; ESPA, DCTRA, FWA, ACWA & AECA**: Mr. Keller updated the board on the dismantle of the DCTRA as they work on getting appraisals for the ponds.

**Eastern Tule GSA**: ETGSA will have a public outreach meeting on November 16, 2021 at 10 am in the Porterville Memorial Building for a basinsafe workshop.

<u>Savings Plan for Employees of TBID</u> – Consider accepting and placing on file the 2021 Savings Plan for the Employees of TBID as audited by Cuttone & Mastro, CPA.
