MONTHLY REPORTS

Treasurer Nelms reviewed with the Board the financial status of the District, including TBID Investment Policy Review in Compliance with SB 564 and SB 866. Included in the review; monthly statements from California Bank & Trust and Local Agency Investment Fund, Friant power Authority revenues and expenditure summary worksheet. Delinquent water account report was reviewed.

TBID preliminary balance sheet as of April 30, 2023, as well as Income Statements for the same period, including a year to date statement, was reviewed.

Albert Smith, Operations Superintendent, presented his monthly operating activities report for May 2023. Mr. Smith stated there were no accidents or injuries to report.

Equipment maintenance and repair included repacking pumps #1, #2 and #3 at station #6. Greased all pumps and motors at stations #7, #8 and #9. Had the 580L repaired, the base plate that holds the stinger was cracked.. Operations maintenance and repair report included weeding and cleaned up at Stations #7, #8, and #9. Rebuilt the office water fill station. No main leaks this month.

WTP average flow through the plant is around 520 gpm. Pulled second quarter THM's

The total precipitation is 19.83 inches YTD. USA locates: 27. Back flow's Tested: 51

SCE will start getting power to the upper wells next week and the rocks on the old line is getting moved.

Manager Geivet presented his monthly report. Manager Geivet discussed the water report, there has been low customer usage during the spring due the rains and noting the District will be off the canal again this November through end of January.

Fraint Water Authority everyone is receiving updates from Jason Phillip by his email newsletter

Friant Power Authority is running both plants and it should be a good year

Status of Authorities; ESPA & AECA: Manager Geivet is continuing to forward news letters by email from AECA; DCTRA termination is complete with 700 form leaving office signed.

Eastern Tule GSA is focused on the billing and lien process they have a public hearing set for June 15, 2023.
