Treasurer Nelms reviewed with the Board the financial status of the District, including TBID Investment Policy Review in Compliance with SB 564 and SB 866. Included in the review; monthly statements from California Bank & Trust, California Asset Management Program and Local Agency Investment Fund, Friant power Authority revenues and expenditure summary worksheet. Delinquent water account report was reviewed.

TBID balance sheet as of May 31, 2024, as well as Income Statements for the same period, including a year to date statement, was reviewed.

The Board of Directors reviewed the Operation Activity Report for June 2024 included in the Board package. Reported no accidents or injuries for the month.

Equipment maintenance and repair included repairing leak on the surge tank at station #9. Greased all pumps and motors at stations #1, #4 and #6.

Operations maintenance and repair report included disc around the treatment plant, disc around tank #4.

1 main line leak; one on the east side of Road 248 about 30 yards north of Aveune 92.

WTP average flow through the plant is around 500 gpm. Pulled 2nd quarter THM's.

The total precipitation is 11.44 inches YTD. USA locates: **213**. Back flow's Tested: 29

Manager Geivet and Engineer Nick Keller presented the monthly reports. Mr. Keller reported the Bureau allocation for 2024-25 decreased from 100% to 90% on July 9, 2024, the Board reviewed the updated water schedule.

Fraint Water Authority: is working on buget for FWA's new year.

Friant Power Authority: Nothing to report.
